a. Award bid for the 2019 Trenchless Pipeline Rehabilitation Project to the lowest, qualified bidder

The District solicited proposals from qualified vendors to perform cured-in-place trenchless sanitary sewer pipeline rehabilitation for approximately 1,556 linear feet of 10-inch sewer main running north to south under the 7<sup>th</sup> St. bridge.

Two bids for this project were received from the following:

Granite Inliner	\$ 76,050

Granite Inliner was the low bidder at \$76,050. Mr. Maness asked if the District had any regulation regarding depth of fill on top of the sewer lines. Mr. Webb and Ms. Nelson are working on revising the Pipeline and Manhole Specifications. They will address this in the revision.

Mr. Maness made a motion to award the 2019 Trenchless Pipeline Rehabilitation Project to Granite Inliner for \$76,050. Mr. Story seconded the motion. The vote was as follows:
